



The NAS "100 Club"

- The 100 Club will be open to NAS members only.
- The cost of numbers to be entered into the monthly draw will be £10 per number.
- Participants must be over 16.
- Payment must either be by standing order for the monthly payment of £10.00 or by standing order or card for the full annual amount of £120.00
- Payment must be received on or before the 1st day of the month in which the draw is taking place.
- Participants may purchase one or more numbers.
- The prizes will be £100 first prize and £50 second prize.
- The prize draw will take place on the 15th, nearest working day, of every month.
- The monthly prize draw to be actioned at the NAS Office at Fort Cumberland.

NAS "100 Club" Rules

1. The 100 Club will operate a Small Lottery as defined by the Gambling Act 2005. NAS trustees will appoint a subcommittee to run the 100 Club and an organizer will be authorized and appointed by the society.
2. NAS reserves the right to alter the Rules of the 100 Club as necessary. Participants will be notified of changes. In no circumstances will changes retrospectively disadvantage any participants. The current up-to-date rules will be shown on the NAS website;
3. All profits made by the 100 Club will be paid to the NAS.
4. Numbers to be entered into the draw may be purchased for £10 per number per month. Members may purchase one or more numbers.
5. Participants must be 16 or over.
6. Payments may be made either by monthly standing order or by annual card payment or standing order.
7. Draws will take place 12 times a year, On the 15th of the month.
8. Numbers not paid for by 2nd of the month will not be entered for the draw that month and may be reallocated.
9. The required number of entries in order for the draw to take place is 20. No payments will be taken until this number or more is reached
10. Amounts of 1x £100 and 1x £50 will be paid out as prizes every month.
11. Prizewinners will be notified via email for confirmation of payment details, and will be paid out via bank transfer, (Winning numbers are available on request.
12. The NAS may wind up the 100 Club at any time and will repay participants' payments made in advance.
