- HMS Invincible/A1 Submarine – RIB Diving out of Portsmouth (Cheque payment to 'Nautical Archaeology Sub-Aqua Club' only)
- Holland 5 Submarine/Norman's Bay Wreck – Hard boat diving out of Eastbourne
